## About Us

The *Jondaryan Woolshed Museum*, open between 9am and 4pm, 363 days a year, includes a unique variety of historical artefacts from yesteryear. We offer guided tours, miniature train rides, working demonstrations, cart horses and wagon rides, damper-making, beekeeping and much more.

The Australian-owned Jondaryan Woolshed Historical Museum, established in 1975, features restored historic buildings, machinery, equipment and collections, many with historic links to the Jondaryan Estates pastoral empire. At its peak in 1892, the Jondaryan Estates encompassed over 300,000 acres, making it the largest freehold station in Queensland at the time.

The renowned 80m *Jondaryan Woolshed*, built between 1859 and 1861 to shear sheep belonging to the Jondaryan Estates, is now the centrepiece of the Museum. It captures the history of Jondaryan Station and its role in the development of pastoralism on the Darling Downs and the wool industry in Australia. Half of the woolshed now incorporates a stage and auditorium; perfect for corporate functions, weddings, group dinners, conferences and other events.

The oldest-existing out-station homestead from the original Jondaryan Estates, *Lagoon Homestead* creates a special ambience for any occasion. Built in the 1880's, it features large wrap-around verandas, a fireplace and unique structure prominent to our pioneering ancestry.

The characteristic *Flagstone Creek Public Hall* was the centre for a thriving pioneering town. Built 78 years previously, this charming hall holds many secrets from yesteryear and is perfect for smaller group functions or more intimate celebrations.

Jondaryan Woolshed is a fully licensed venue, and with an international chef and accommodation on-site, your group's needs are easily catered for... There really is something for everyone!

The available on-site accommodation for overnight or longer stays includes laundry facilities and a camp kitchen with an open fire for guest use. The Jondaryan Woolshed grounds offer many accommodation options to choose from, including: cottages, rustic cabins, shearers' quarters, caravan and camping sites with tent hire available on request.

There are many festivals and events being held at the Jondaryan Woolshed throughout the year – groups are welcome at any of these festivities and the Events manager can give you a separate price for daily visits or overnight stays during these times.

Our famous Brunch, held on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of each month of the year, boasts a smorgasbord of scrumptious freshly home cooked foods and live entertainment. It costs \$25 per person, which includes: the all-you-can-eat buffet, entertainment, entry to the museum, guided tours and more!
